September 12, 2022 Meeting Minutes

Rev. Shirley Bowen described the mission of Seeds of Hope Neighborhood Center, which is located at 35 South Street, and the services that are offered to 'neighbors'. These services include:

- Providing meals
- Assistance with access to healthcare, including vaccinations, testing, and connecting people with a PCP
- Hep C and HIV testing
- Coordination with the City's People Recover program for those struggling with substance use
- Overnight warming center in winter months and daytime cooling center in summer months
- Health education/food tips
- Violence No More classes
- Will soon be offering a shower and providing shower supplies that can be stored at the center

Rev. Shirley shared some of the challenges that she sees neighbors struggle with, including:

- Challenges with accessing IDs – often need two forms and one with address
- Comments from the community/judgement
- Substance use disorder and availability of treatment
- Finding employment due to criminal history

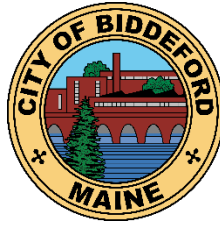
There are an estimated 50-60 people in our community experiencing homelessness at this time. Rev. Shirley discussed some of the myths around homelessness – those experiencing homelessness do not feel entitled, they don't deserve it, and there is no scarcity of resources (there is funding available for people experiencing homelessness and people experiencing other challenges to all be assisted).

Some suggested ideas for areas that the DEI Committee could assist in were to create a registry of employers within the city who would hire folks with a criminal history, or organize a job fair with these employers. Additionally, in terms of inclusivity, acknowledging that we have homelessness in Biddeford and treating those experiencing homelessness with dignity (greeting them when passing by, etc) is key.

The Committee will be joined by Recreation Director Carl Walsh at the next meeting and determined that they would start discussions about Recreation programming once he is present. The next meeting has been set for Monday, October 3 at 5:30 p.m.

In your agenda packet for this month, you will find much of the information that you had requested about the Recreation Department at our last meeting. Some of this information will be more valuable with the Recreation Director, Carl Walsh, present to answer your questions. He plans to attend your next meeting. I will do my best to answer clarifying questions at our meeting on Monday and will pass along any questions that I am not able to answer.

List of Programs

From July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022 the Department offered a total of 74 different programs, many with multiple offerings within its category (for example, Cub Care offered a 3, 4 or 5-day option). The 50+ Club offered a total of 17 day trips during the year.

A complete list of programs that was pulled from the Rec Department's online programming registration system was included in your packet.

Staffing Levels

The Rec Department has:

- 10 Full-time positions
- 20-25 Part-time positions
- 25-50 Seasonal positions
- 100-110 Current volunteers

Accessibility of Facilities

In August 2021, the City conducted an ADA self-evaluation with Disability Access Consultants (DAC) of programs, services, activities, parks and facilities. The goal of the evaluation is that all potential physical and programmatic

barriers for accessibility for persons with disabilities are brought to compliance over time. As a part of the scope of work, DAC looked at 30 facilities and parks throughout the community.

All Recreation locations in Biddeford were included in the evaluation:

- Canopy Park (65 Bacon St)

- Gilbert R Boucher Memorial Park/Pool Beach
- J Richard Martin Community Center
- Mechanics Park
- Memorial Park (Mayfield)
- Park in the Pines - Hills Beach (194 Hills Beach Rd)
- Pierson's Lane Playground (Corner of Bacon St and Piersons Ln)
- Rotary Park and Biddeford Teen Center
- Shevenell Park (149 Main St)
- St. Louis Field
- Vines Landing (Lester B. Orcutt Blvd)
- Waterhouse Field
- William A. Doran Sr. Field (314 South St)
- Williams Court Park (Williams Court and South St)

This does not include any locations outside of City facilities where programming may take place – for instance, 50+ Club trips or summer camp trips.

The complete [Transition Plan](#) has about 1600 pages of recommended improvements. Their priority level is ranked one through four, and there are suggested dates for completion given in the report for each item based on their level of priority.

Cost to Run/Fee Structure for Programs

Most Rec programs are designed to be self-sustaining, meaning that the fees that are paid in to the program are used to cover the expenses. Staff plans for activities and programming to offer that they feel is a balance of affordable and entertaining/enriching, and the fees for those programs are set based on actual costs. There are separate “funds” for different types of programming (Adult Sports, Teen Center, Summer Camps, etc) to keep track of the revenues and expenses of each program.

I have attached the budgets for each of these funds, as well as the Recreation Department's General Fund budget (the one labeled 21124). Anything covered in the General Fund budget does not come directly from program fees – rather, it comes from property taxes.

The information that I've provided is actually the budget *requests* for this year as opposed to the finalized budgets, so there may have been some small changes to the budgets that were actually approved. The budget requests give you a more informative breakdown of what you are looking at, so I thought they would be most helpful.

One item of note is that the budgets that were approved for this year do not account for recent wage changes for some of our part-time and seasonal employees that were made to keep up with the marketplace. These wage increases are likely to affect programming fees moving forward.

Carl will be able to answer your questions with more details about how funding decisions are made.

Financial Aid

One of the topics that the Committee was especially interested in was financial aid for program participants. The Recreation Department has its own internal Financial Aid program. The application uses federal poverty guidelines to determine who qualifies for funding and at what level. Additionally, if the School Department recommends support of a student or family based on needs that may not be seen through the application process, they can also receive aid. Applicants get approved to use the funding for a specific program, such as Cub Care or the Summer Camp program. There is a budget of \$30,000 for the year that was allocated by the Council, and the Department is already over the budget for the year based on the need that they saw with the Summer Camp program. Additional support for families in need beyond the \$30,000 budget is essentially covered by other families in the programs.

There is also a State aid program, which is administered by the Department of Health and Human Services or Spurwink. The guidelines for this aid is determined by caseworkers and not by the Rec Department.

"Who is the Department serving now?"

One of the questions that was asked by the committee was, "Who is the Department serving?". The Rec Department does not keep any sort of formal demographic data about program participants. We do know that there are 3,331 registrants in our online registration portal. As a note, some public events like the annual Easter Egg Hunt or holiday activities do not require registration.

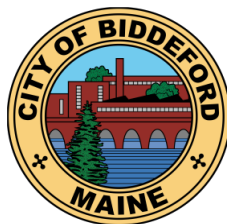
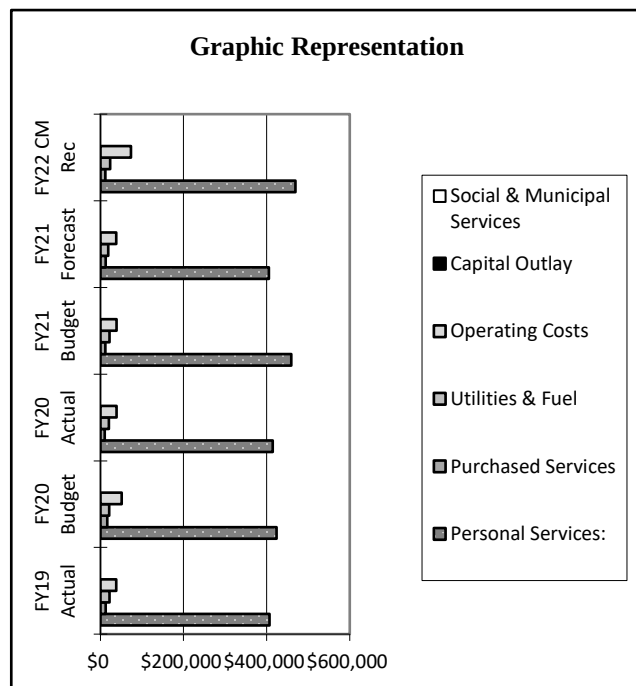
