The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by the Chair, Councilor John McCurry.

Present: Chair, Council President, John McCurry; Mayor Alan Casavant; Councilor Stephen St. Cyr; Councilor Mike Ready; City Manager, Jim Bennett; and City Clerk, Carmen Morris.

Adjustment to the Agenda
No adjustment to the agenda.

Approval of Minutes of July 6, 2021

Motion by Councilor Ready to accept the minutes as printed, seconded by Councilor St. Cyr.

Vote: unanimous.

Expenditure Warrants:

The Warrants were available for the Committee members to review and sign.

Discussion/Approval

Approval/Replacement of Video Recorder - Addition of Cameras at Public Works Department/Minuteman Security Technologies

Motion by Councilor Ready to approve the replacement of the video recorder and additional cameras at the Public Works Department, contract to be awarded to Minuteman Security Technologies, seconded by Councilor St. Cyr.

Discussion: Councilor St. Cyr asked about the funding source for the project. Chief Operating Officer, Brian Phinney, explained the project is funded from FY21 CIP funds that have been carried over.

Councilor McCurry had concerns this is a sole source purchase and does not want this to be the norm.

Approval/Domain Migration of Police and Fire Departments Domain to Biddeford Domain/Systems Engineering

Recommendation/Lease-Purchase of Fire Pumper/Engine Truck/Dingee Machine Company, an Authorized Representative for Sutphen Corporation

Motion by Councilor Ready to recommend the lease-purchase of a Fire Pumper/Engine Truck from Dingee Machine Company, which is an authorized representative for Stuphen Corporation, seconded by Councilor St. Cyr.

Discussion: Councilor Ready asked about the funding for this equipment. The City Manager provided an explanation. Councilor Ready asked what were the deductions, they were not provided. Fire Chief Gagne will get the deductions to the Committee.

Councilor St. Cyr asked why there's a difference of about \$200,000.00 from the budgeted to what the quote came in at. The Chief explained the budget numbers were put together last year and there have been numerous increases on the vendor's part.

Councilor McCurry asked how many hours are on the current truck. Chief Gagne noted the truck is a 1995 and there are 3,000 hours on the truck that is being replaced. Councilor McCurry asked about the trade in. The Chief explained the vendors were hesitant to give us a number mainly because we are about 18 months out. We may be better off to sell it on our own. Assistant Public Works Director, Jerry Court, explained it simply doesn't meet the needs of the department, especially at 26 years old.

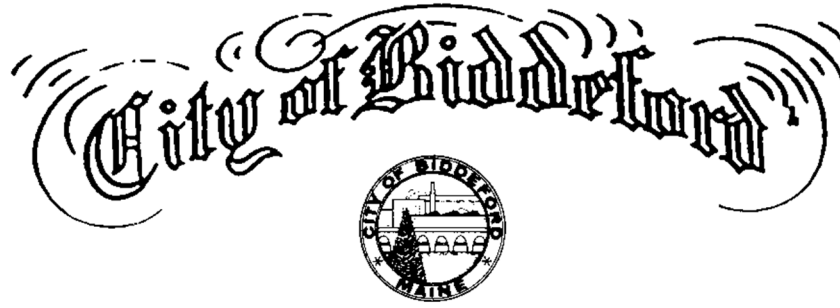
