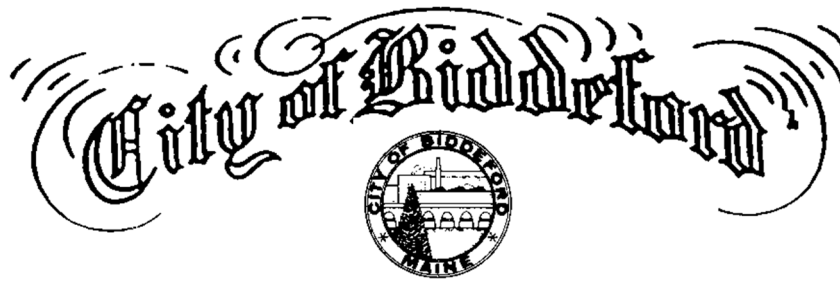

IN BOARD OF CITY COUNCIL...SEPTEMBER 4, 2018

BE IT ORDERED, by the City Council of the City of Biddeford that the following fee structure be adopted for the municipal lots designated as Alfred Street Parking Lot, Downtown Parking Lot, Franklin Street Parking Lot, Federal Street Parking Lot, Foss Street Parking Lot, Gas House Parking Lot, Washington Street Parking Lot, and Wastewater Parking Lot to be programmed into parking permit kiosks as follows:

Short-term <u>hourly</u> rate:	\$ 2.00/hour	\$ 1.00/hour
Long-term (Mon-Fri. 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.)	\$50.00/month	\$30.00/month
Long-term (6:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.- all day Sat/Sun):	\$35.00/month	\$20.00/month
Long-term (24/7):	\$65.00/month	\$40.00/month
Winter Parking Ban	\$ 5.00/storm	\$ 2.00/storm

Motion by Councilor Lessard, seconded by Councilor McCurry to amend the order by removing the first two columns (7/01/22 and 5/01/19) and keeping only the fees effective 11/01/18.

Councilors Lessard, McCurry and Quattrone in favor.

Vote: 5/4; Councilors Lessard, Quattrone, St. Cyr and Swanton opposed.

Councilors McCurry, Foley, Belanger, Ready and Seaver in favor.

Amendment carries.

Vote on order, as amended: 6/3; Councilors Lessard, Quattrone and Swanton opposed.

Councilors McCurry, St. Cyr, Foley, Belanger, Ready and Seaver in favor.
