Item 2.c. DC2021.03) Review/Amend Article V, Specific Street Regulations, Sec. 42-92 Limited Parking – Windsor Lane

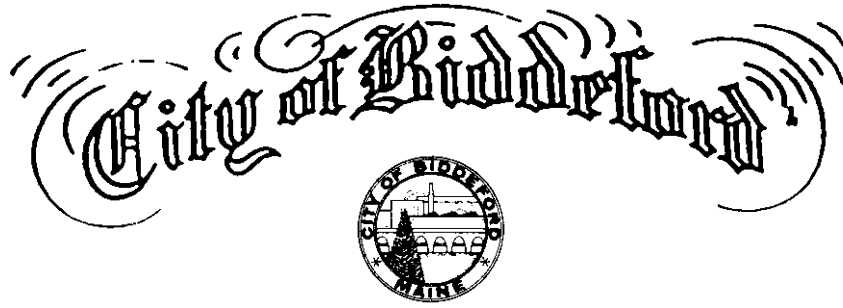
